- The scheduling of this initial test is passenger's responsibility and at passenger cost.
- CVS Pharmacy is suggested because they send the result electronically by email. Whatever you select, it must be performed by a recognized lab, not a home test kit.
- Make a copy to carry throughout the tour for use at the airport(s).



Fill in the health declaration form/Entry Statement and upload the vaccination certificate (if you have one) and the PCR Test result 48 hours prior to your arrival in Israel

Print out AND save a digital copy of the completed form and carry it with you. You will receive an immediate notification – cleared or not-cleared. If you do not meet the requirements in the health declaration, you won't be allowed to board the flight. Contact the airline immediately in this case. It is needed at the airport (s).

- Rep. escorts group to the Passport Biometric Check point
- Rep. escorts group to the Baggage Claim Area everyone look for their flight number above the carousel
- Group gathers near Rep. after getting luggage
- Rep. takes the Group to the Covid-19 PCR Testing Area, where another PCR test will be done (\$35)
- Rep. escorts the group to the coach to meet the guide, driver and Immanuel Tours Representatives you receive a cap, sturdy canvas backpack and map
- Additional information will be given on the drive to the hotel.



A final test, required by the US CDC will be done the morning of departure, as a group, at the hotel. (\$35)

Before departure you will receive a statement from TLC Holyland Tours by mail, with the charges for Covid-Related required tests and insurance.
