

Day 1 – Monday Depart USA on Delta Airlines from TYS

Day 2 - Tuesday

Arrive in Israel | Drive to your hotel on the Mediterranean Sea

You will be met by a representative to assist the group through customs and provide transfer to your hotel. You will check in, have a lovely dinner overlooking the Mediterranean Sea and then get a good night's rest.

Day 3 - Wednesday

Caesarea Maritima | Mt. Carmel | Valley of Armageddon | Megiddo | Nazareth | arrive on the Sea of Galilee

The day begins with a drive up the coast to the ancient port city of Caesarea Maritime where the ancient harbor, hippodrome and great theatre stand. The events of Acts 12 took place there. Close by you will see the aqueducts built by Herod the Great and then view the Valley of Armageddon from the heights of Mt. Carmel where Elijah slew the prophets of Baal. Descending from there you will visit Megiddo, Solomon's Ancient chariot city, view Ahab's water tunnel, cross the entire Jezreel Valley and begin the climb through the lower Galilean Mountains to Nazareth, the childhood home of Jesus. Finally, you arrive at your beautiful hotel on the shore of the Sea of Galilee where you will have dinner and spend the first of three nights..

Day 4 - Thursday

Sea of Galilee | Jesus Boat | Mount of Beatitudes | Tabgha | Capernaum | Lunch by the Sea | Baptism

You will wake to a breath-taking sunrise on the Sea of Galilee. After breakfast, enjoy a boat ride and time of worship on the Sea of Galilee as you sail to Nof Ginnosar in a replica of an ancient boat. The authentic 2,000-year-old boat of antiquity dates to the time of Christ. You will follow the steps of Jesus through the Galilee region as you visit the Mt. of Beatitudes and ancient Capernaum, Tabgha and the ancient fisherman's landing called the "Primacy of Peter." You will enjoy lunch by the Sea of Galilee where you will have an opportunity to eat "St. Peter's fish," tilapia, caught fresh out of the waters of the Galilee. The group will complete the day with the opportunity for baptism in the Jordan River. After this wonderful day, you can once again relax at your hotel on the Sea of Galilee. After dinner you may enjoy looking out over this beautiful lake to reflect on what you are already experiencing; walking where Jesus walked.

Day 5 - Friday

Chorazin | Tel Dan | Bental | Dan Nature Reserve | Caesarea Philippi | Northern Golan Heights

The beautiful northern mountains of Israel await you today. At Tel Dan, there is a city gate from the time of Abraham along with an altar from the days of Israel's divided kingdom. You will get to walk through an incredible nature reserve at Dan where you will see the beginnings of the Dan River, which joins with other streams to form the Jordan River. The water is crystal-clear and

pure. You will see a gorgeous waterfall as the headwaters of the Jordan River cascade into a beautiful mountain stream. Your next stop will be the site of the Apostle Peter's confession of Christ at Caesarea Philippi. You will see the second source of the Jordan River at Banias. You will hear an explanation of Israel's incredible history from 1948 until the present as you stand upon the heights of the extant volcano peak. You can see the Golan Heights spanning from the Northern border to the Sea of Galilee and learn about the strategic importance this region has played and will continue to play to the nation of Israel. After your day in the mountains, you will retire to your hotel.

Day 6 - Saturday

Beit She'an | Wadi Qelt | Jerusalem - Mt. of Olives

This morning you leave the beautiful Sea of Galilee, following alongside the Gilboa mountain range. At Harrod's springs you will see where Judge Gideon tested his men before the battle with the Midianites in the valley between Gilboa and Mt. Moreh. From there you will visit the last site before your journey down the Jordan Valley, Bet Shan. While not mentioned in the New Testament, it is an Old Testament city and the best preserved Roman city from that period in Israel today. You will have lunch, a break and then onward to Jerusalem. After passing by ancient Jericho the climb to Jerusalem begins while viewing scenery and traveling the same route the ancient pilgrims would have taken as they made their journey to Jerusalem for the great feasts of Israel. Today you finally arrive in the City of God, the City of David and the ancient and modern capital of Israel, Jerusalem. Your heart will leap with emotion as you stand on the overlooks of the Mount of Olives and see the breathtaking Mountain of Moriah. It is there where Abraham was to offer Isaac, Solomon built the first temple, and where Jesus walked, taught, died, rose again and will one day return in great glory! This is only the beginning. You check into your hotel, have dinner and enjoy your first night in your lovely hotel in Jerusalem

Day 7 - Sunday

Qumran | Masada | Ein Gedi | Dead Sea

You will spend an exciting morning descending to the Plains of Jericho; then on to the Dead Sea, the lowest spot on earth; and Qumran, the center of the Essenes. Qumran is home of the ancient caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. From there, we will continue south to the desert where ibex roam at Ein Gedi, David's hideout from Saul. Then we go on to the mighty fortress Masada, the last stronghold and stand of the zealots against Rome, on the edge of the barren Negev Desert. Masada is a symbol of courage and perseverance for the Jewish people, where 960 Jewish defenders organized their last resistance to the roman conquerors and took their own lives rather than surrender into slavery. Those who wish to do so may swim (float) in the salty waters of the Dead Sea. You will then follow the ancient path the pilgrims followed ascending to Jerusalem and retire to your hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Days 8 - 9 Monday - Tuesday

JERUSALEM! These final days are spent in and around Jerusalem, the ancient capital. Once you arrive in Jerusalem, before disembarking each afternoon, you will hear the next day's itinerary. Listed below are just some of the sights you will experience.

Payment by an individual or for an individual affirms your agreement to these terms and conditions.

AIR MILES: TLC Holyland highly discourages the use of air miles for group travel. Air Miles Disclaimer applies. Passenger assumes all risks and responsibility.

PRICE is per person based on double occupancy in a double bedded room. Flights are group economy class. Single rooms are subject to availability with an additional charge. If a roommate is unavailable, passenger must pay the supplemental charge. (*Passenger may be billed after the final payment due date for single room accommodations.*)

REGISTRATION is required per person and to hold a space must include a \$500 deposit (may be made via PayPal if registering online). Registrations by mail require a \$500 deposit by check. Late registration begins the day after the "due in full" date. Late registrations incur a \$150 late penalty, and payment is due in full when reservation is submitted. (If online, \$500 through PayPal, the balance must be sent by overnight mail to TLC Holyland Tours.)

DUE DATE is as indicated. Reservations not paid in full by the due date are subject to cancellation.

SEATING is group economy class. Upgrades and associated costs are the sole responsibility of the passenger after e-ticket confirmation. Airlines no longer accept seating requests in Economy without submission of a physician's letter.

DEVIATION from the group itinerary is not allowed.

TIPS are not included in the Tour Price but will be included on the final billing.

AIRPORT DEPARTURE TAXES AND FUEL SURCHARGES are not included in the **estimated** Tour Price and are subject to change by the airline. If there is a substantial difference it will be included on the final billing.

FLIGHTS if not specifically included in the tour package, or additional travel arrangements to the international departure point are the sole responsibility of the participant. (If purchasing domestic tickets more than 60 days in advance of departure date consider purchase of a flexible ticket allowing no charge or minimal charge for flight changes, as flight times can change for the group up to the time of ticketing.) Arrive at the airport of international departure $3\frac{1}{2}$ - 4 hours before flight departure time. TLC Holyland Tours is not responsible for changes to the flight schedule.

If personal reservations are necessary to connect to the international group flight, TLC strongly recommends use of the airline being used by the group for ease of assistance if requesting luggage be sent straight through. You are also more likely to receive prompt assistance if difficulties in scheduling arise. However, if no domestic flight is included in this package, passengers may use the airline of choice. Allow adequate time for connections in case of unforeseen delay. TLC Holyland Tours will not be available to assist, in any way, with personal reservations.

TRANSPORTATION is by modern air-conditioned-coach and by jet, economy class seating. Upgrades and associated costs are the sole responsibility of the passenger <u>after e-tickets are issued.</u>

PASSPORTS as required by Israeli law, must be valid for six months after the final day of stay in Israel. Passport cards are not acceptable travel documents. Your passport will be used for plane tickets and entrance/exit to/from Israel.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS require you to be in good health – able to climb stairs and ascending grades without assistance; walk 3 -5 miles at a moderate pace on uneven terrain, and able to transport your own luggage. If you need assistance you must provide, at your cost someone to do this for you.

FOR YOUR PROTECTION TRIP INSURANCE IS REQUIRED.

Very few US Medical policies give coverage outside the USA.
