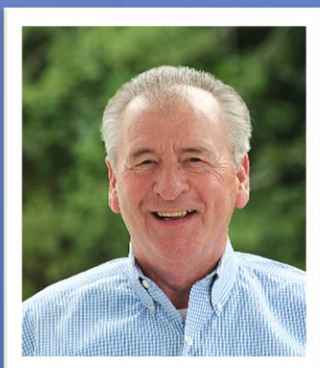

Day 1 – Tuesday

Depart USA on Delta Airlines from Charleston, SC

Day 2 – Wednesday

Arrive in Israel | Drive to your hotel on the Mediterranean Sea

You will be met by a representative at the airport, escorted through the process then provided transfer to the hotel on the Mediterranean Sea.

Day 3 – Thursday

Caesarea Maritima | Mt. Carmel | Jezreel Valley | Megiddo | Nazareth |

Arrive on the Sea of Galilee

The day begins with a drive up the coast to the ancient port city of Caesarea Maritime where the ancient harbor, hippodrome and great theatre stand. The events of Acts 12 took place there. Close by you will see the aqueducts built by Herod the Great. From the heights of Mt. Carmel where Elijah slew the prophets of Baal view the Valley of Armageddon, then on to Megiddo, Solomon's ancient chariot city. Cross the Jezreel Valley, climb through the lower Galilean Mountains to Nazareth, the childhood home of Jesus. Your beautiful hotel overlooks the Sea of Galilee where you will have dinner and overnight.

Day 4 – Friday

Sea of Galilee | Boat ride and time of worship | Jesus Boat | Mount of Beatitudes | Tabgha | Capernaum | [Magdala if time permits](#) | Fish Lunch by the Sea | Baptism in the Jordan River

You will wake to a breath-taking sunrise on the Sea of Galilee then enjoy a boat ride and time of worship on the Sea of Galilee sailing to Nof Ginosar in a replica of an ancient boat. The authentic 2,000-year-old boat dates to the time of Christ. Following the steps of Jesus through the Galilee region as you visit the Mt. of Beatitudes, ancient Capernaum, Tabgha and the ancient fisherman's landing called the "Primacy of Peter." Lunch by the Sea of Galilee allows you the opportunity to eat "St. Peter's fish," tilapia, caught fresh out of the Sea. You complete the day with the opportunity for baptism in the Jordan River. Returning to your hotel you have dinner and can enjoy the beautiful sparkling city lights at nightfall on the opposite shore.

Day 5 – Saturday

[Chorazin](#) | Tel Dan Nature Reserve | Bental | Caesarea Philippi | Northern Golan Heights

The beautiful northern mountains of Israel await you today. At Tel Dan, see the city gate from the time of Abraham and an altar from the days of Israel's divided kingdom. Walk through the incredible nature reserve where you see the beginnings of the Dan River, crystal clear and pure which joins with other streams to form the Jordan River. A gorgeous waterfall at the headwaters of the Jordan River cascade into a beautiful mountain stream. Next is the site of the Apostle Peter's confession of Christ at Caesarea Philippi where you see the second source of the Jordan River at Banias. The explanation of Israel's incredible history from 1948 until the present will astound you as you stand on the heights of the extant volcano peak. You will see the Golan Heights spanning from the Northern border to the Sea

of Galilee and learn the strategic importance of this region for the nation of Israel. Afterwards you will retire to your hotel on the Sea of Galilee for a final evening

Day 6 – Sunday

Beit She'an | Masada | Ein Gedi | Qumran | Wadi Qelt | Jerusalem | Mt. of Olives

This morning you leave the beautiful Sea of Galilee and follow alongside the Gilboa mountain range. You will make a quick stop to view the ruins of one of the ten cities of the Decapolis. While not mentioned in the New Testament, it is an Old Testament city and the best preserved Roman city from that period in Israel today. Traveling down the Jordan Valley, after passing by the Plains of ancient Jericho, the day will be spent in the desert viewing Masada, Ein Gedi, and Qumran next to the Dead Sea, the lowest spot on earth. The stories of what transpired at all three sites are spell binding; ancient caves, Ibx, strongholds, a hidden oasis – the significance of all is remarkable! After this incredible afternoon you will make a stop at Wadi Qelt before beginning the climb along the ancient path the pilgrims followed ascending to Jerusalem After a quick stop on the Mount of Olives, you will retire to your hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Days 7, 8 and 9 Monday - Wednesday will be spent in and around JERUSALEM!

These final days are spent in and around Jerusalem, the ancient capital Once you arrive in Jerusalem, before disembarking each afternoon, you will hear the next day's itinerary. Listed below are just some of the sights you will experience.

Payment by an individual or for an individual affirms your agreement to these terms and conditions.

TLC Holyland Tours or its representatives, reserves the right to amend the itinerary based on conditions on the ground,

AIR MILES: TLC Holyland highly discourages the use of air miles for group travel. Air Miles Disclaimer applies. Passenger assumes all risks and responsibility.

PRICE is per person based on double occupancy in a double bedded room. Flights are group economy class. Single rooms are subject to availability with an additional charge. If no roommate is available, passenger must pay the supplemental charge and may be billed after final billing was sent.

REGISTRATION is required per person and to hold a space must include a \$500 deposit (payable by PayPal/credit card if registering online). Registration by mail require \$500 deposit by check. Late registration begins after the "due in full" date, incurs a \$150 late penalty, and cost is due in full when reservation is submitted. (If online, \$500 through PayPal, the balance must be sent by overnight mail to TLC Holyland Tours for all late registrations.)

DUE DATE is as indicated. Reservations not paid in full by the due date are subject to cancellation.

SEATING is group economy class. Seat numbers will be assigned by the airline at check-in. Specific seat request cannot be guaranteed. Physician's letter required for seating request due to medical needs.

DEVIATION is not permitted on group fares.

TIPS are not included in the Tour Base Price but will be included on the final bill.

AIRPORT DEPARTURE TAXES AND FUEL SURCHARGES are not included in the *estimated* Tour Price and are subject to change by the airline. TLC Holyland reserves the right to pass along fuel surcharges or additional taxes imposed by the airline.

FLIGHTS if not specifically included in the tour package, or additional travel arrangements to the international departure point are the passenger's responsibility. (If purchasing domestic tickets more than 60 days in advance of departure, consider purchase of a flexible ticket allowing no charge or minimal charge for flight changes. Flight schedule can change up to time of ticketing.) Arrive at the airport of international departure 3½ - 4 hours before flight departure time. TLC Holyland Tours is not responsible for changes to the flight schedule.

If personal reservations are necessary to connect to the international group flight, TLC strongly recommends use of the airline being used by the group for ease of assistance if requesting luggage be sent straight through. However, if no domestic flight is included in this package, passengers may use the airline of choice. Allow adequate time for connections in case of unforeseen delay. TLC Holyland Tours will not be available to assist, in any way, with personal reservations.

TRANSPORTATION is by modern air-conditioned-coach and by jet, economy class seating. Upgrades and associated costs are the sole responsibility of the passenger after e-tickets are issued.

PASSPORTS and Visas: Citizens of the USA, Canada and most western nations do not need a visa to enter Israel, only a **valid passport with expiration date at least 6 months beyond your travel dates.** Citizens of other nations need to inquire with the Israeli consular services in their country. Passport cards are not acceptable travel documents. Your passport will be used for plane tickets and entrance/exit to/from Israel.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: 1 checked bag under 50 lbs., meeting required airline dimension, 1 carry-on (place medications, valuables, passports, change of clothing in carry-on), 1 personal item (i.e., purse laptop bag, backpack, camera).

FOR YOUR PROTECTION TRIP INSURANCE IS REQUIRED. All passengers are required to provide proof of trip insurance including medical coverage.

Very few US Medical policies give coverage outside the USA. Acting only as agents for suppliers, TLC Holyland Tours, LLC is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, personal injury, accident and/or illness or repatriation. As a courtesy to passengers, information and application forms may be viewed on our website. **It is the responsibility of the traveler to select a provider (there are hundreds) and a plan. TLC is not responsible if you cancel your trip and choose not to use the insurance purchased. No refund will come from TLC Holyland Tours concerning any purchased insurance.** Carry proof of medical and travel insurance while in transit.
