PROPOSED ITINERARY

Order of sites may change based on flight schedule and conditions on the ground.

Day 1 – Sunday

Today you will leave the United States on a trans-continental flight to Tel Aviv, Israel.

Day 2 – Monday

Land Israel | Caesarea Maritima | Mt. Carmel | Valley of Armageddon | Megiddo | Nazareth | Arrive for dinner and 1st overnight on the Sea of Galilee

You will be met by a representative to assist the group through customs and begin touring. Begin the day by driving up the coast to the ancient port of Caesarea Maritima and see the ancient capital of the Romans in Palestine with the great theatre, hippodrome and harbor. The events of Acts 12 took place here; the Apostle Paul's imprisonment, his bringing the gospel to the house of Cornelias, and the occasion of Herod being struck by worms in the theatre. A short distance away you will see the incredible aqueducts built by Herod the Great and a later period Crusader fortress nearby. After a short drive along the coast you begin the climb up the Carmel Mountains to the heights of Mt. Carmel where Elijah slew the prophets of Baal. The view of the Valley of Armageddon will take your breath away as you recall the prophecies of Revelation and the end-time events that will take place in that vast plain. You will descend into the valley and visit Megiddo, Solomon's ancient chariot city, cross the entire valley and begin the climb through the lower Galilean Mountains to Nazareth, the childhood home of Jesus to see the astounding view of the valley. Leaving Nazareth you drive through areas where ancient villages of His day stood, such as Cana, where He turned the water into wine. Finally, you arrive at your beautiful hotel where you will have dinner and spend the first of three nights.

Day 3 – Tuesday

Sea of Galilee | Boat Ride & Time of Worship | Jesus Boat | Mount of Beatitudes | Tabgha | Capernaum | Fish Lunch | Migdal, time permitting | Baptism in the Jordan |

Awaken to a breath-taking sunrise on the Sea of Galilee, then enjoy a boat ride and time of worship on the Sea of Galilee sailing to Nof Ginosar in a replica of an ancient boat. On arriving, view an authentic 2,000-year-old boat of antiquity dating to the time of Christ. Follow the steps of Jesus through the Galilee region, visit the Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum, Tabgha and the ancient fisherman's landing called the "Primacy of Peter." Enjoy lunch near the Sea and have an opportunity to eat "St. Peter's fish," tilapia, caught fresh from the waters of the Galilee. Complete the day with baptism in the Jordan River if you choose. If time permits, you will visit the incredible ruins of Migdal before returning to the hotel. After dinner enjoy looking out over the beautiful lake to reflect on what you are already experiencing; walking where Jesus walked.

Day 4 – Wednesday

Chorazin | Tel Dan | Dan Nature Reserve | Mt. Bental | Caesarea Philippi | Northern Golan Heights

The beautiful northern mountains of Israel await you today. First you will stop at Chorazin, the city cursed by Jesus for its lack of response to His message where there are great ruins of an ancient synagogue. Leaving there, you travel to Tel Dan where a city gate from the time of Abraham has been uncovered, along with an altar from the days of Israel's divided kingdom. Walk through an incredible nature reserve at Dan where you will see the beginnings of the Dan River, which joins with other streams to form the Jordan River. The water is crystal-clear and pure. You will see a gorgeous waterfall as the headwaters of the Jordan River cascade into a beautiful mountain stream. Your next stop will be the site of the Apostle Peter's confession of Christ at Caesarea Philippi where you will see the second source of the Jordan River at Banias. Hear an explanation of Israel's incredible history from 1948 until the present as you stand upon the heights of the extinct volcano peak. You will see the Golan Heights spanning from the Northern border to the Sea of Galilee and learn about the strategic importance this region has played and will continue to play to the nation of Israel. After the day in the mountains, retire to your hotel for a final evening in the region.

Day 5 – Thursday

Beth Shean | Masada | Ein Gedi | Qumran | Wadi Qelt | ascend to Jerusalem | Mt. of Olives overlook | Jerusalem, 1st night

This morning you leave the beautiful Sea of Galilee and follow alongside the Gilboa mountain range. You will stop to view the ruins of one of the ten cities of the Decapolis Beit Shan. While not mentioned in the New Testament, it is an Old Testament city and the best preserved Roman city from that period in Israel today. Then we descend to the Plains of Jericho and on to the Dead Sea, the lowest spot on earth. We'll visit the center of the Essenes, Qumran, home of some of the caves where ancient Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. We then continue south into the desert where ibex roam at Ein Gedi, David's hideout from Saul, then on to the mighty fortress Masada, the last stronghold and stand of the zealots against Rome, on the edge of the barren Negev Desert. Masada is a symbol of courage and perseverance for the Jewish people, where 960 Jewish defenders organized their last resistance to the Roman conquerors and took their own lives rather than surrender into slavery. Your final stop before beginning the climb along the ancient path the pilgrims followed, ascending to Jerusalem is Wadi Qelt where you will hear about the Valley of the Shadow of Death. Stop just inside the city for your first view of Jerusalem, the place God loves like no other, then check-in, have dinner, and spend your first night in the city where God put His name...Jerusalem!

Day 6 Friday

Yad Vashem | Mt. of Olives | Palm Sunday Road | Garden of Gethsemane | St. Peter in Gallicantu

The day begins at the site that every visitor to Israel must see, Yad Vashem or the Holocaust Museum. This is Israel's memorial to the 6 million Jews who were put to death by Adolf Hitler and the Nazi regime of Germany during the days of WWII. This is a moving experience that includes a visit to the children's museum in memory of the 2 million children who were sent to their deaths at the hands of the Nazis. Then, proceeding to the Mt. of Olives you will hear an introduction to Jerusalem. Ascend the mountains of Jerusalem from Scopus to the

Mt. of Olives for an outstanding and breath-taking view of the city across the Kidron Valley to the Eastern Gate. Walking Palm Sunday Road you will see the Chapel of Ascension, Pater Noster and Dominus Flevit. After a visit to the Garden of Gethsemane You visit the house of Caiaphas (Gallicantu) where Jesus was tried.

Day 7 - Saturday

Israel Museum | Ecce Homo-Place of the Pavement | Via Dolorosa | Gordon's Calvary | Garden Tomb | Communion

The day begins at the Israel Museum to view the Dead Sea Scrolls and the incredible model of the city of Jerusalem. You will then visit the Fortress of Antonia, seat of the Roman Procurator, site of the public trial of Christ, and his condemnation and scourging. Pavement from the day of Jesus reveals the Game of the Kings. You then make your way along the Via Dolorosa and Calvary to the nearby Garden Tomb. You will complete your tour of Israel this afternoon at Calvary and the Garden Tomb.

Day 8 - Sunday

Temple Mount | Pools of Bethesda | St. Anne's Church | Kotel | Davidson Center | Southern Steps | City of David

This morning you rise early to visit the most sacred place on earth, Mt. Moriah. You will visit the Temple Mount and the centuries old "Dome of the Rock" built 688 – 691 A.D. Exiting into the Jewish Quarter you will visit the Western Wall. You will visit the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus healed an invalid man and visit St. Anne's Church. Today you will visit the Davidson Center and see the ancient Roman Cardo, Robinson's Arch and have a time of teaching where Jesus would have taught the crowds, the ancient Southern Steps. You will end the day exploring the ancient City of David before a delightful Farewell Meeting dinner, and your final night in Jerusalem.

Day 9 - Monday

Early morning flight to the USA from Tel Aviv

You will leave the hotel this morning for a mid-day flight from Tel Aviv to Atlanta. We pray your memories of this life-changing journey will encourage you to bring your friends and return to Israel with TLC Holyland Tours!

***JERUSALEM!** These final days are spent in and around Jerusalem, the ancient capital. Once you arrive, before disembarking each afternoon, you will hear the next day's itinerary. Listed below are just some of the sights you will experience together.

Registration by you or someone on your behalf constitutes your agreement to these terms and conditions.

AIR MILES: TLC Holyland highly discourages the use of air miles for group travel. Air Miles Disclaimer applies. Passenger assumes all risks and responsibility.

PRICE is per person based on double occupancy in a double-bedded room. Flights are group economy class. Single rooms are subject to availability with an additional charge. If a roommate is unavailable, passenger must pay the supplemental charge. *(Passenger may be billed after the final payment due date for single room accommodations.)*

REGISTRATION is required to hold a space with a required \$500 deposit (may be made via PayPal if registering online). Registrations by mail require the deposit by check. Late registration begins the day after the "due in full" date, incur a \$150 late penalty, and are due in full with reservation. (If online, \$500 may be through PayPal, with balance sent by overnight mail to TLC Holyland Tours.)

DUE DATE is as indicated. Reservations not paid in full by the due date are subject to cancellation without notification.

SEATING is group economy class. Upgrades should be requested 75 days before departure and costs are the sole responsibility of the passenger at the time confirmation is requested. Airlines no longer accept seating requests in Economy without submission of a physician's letter.

DEVIATION from the group itinerary is not allowed.

TIPS are not included in the Tour Price but will be included on the final billing.

AIRPORT DEPARTURE TAXES AND FUEL SURCHARGES are not included in the *estimated* price and are subject to change by the airline. At time of ticketing, if there is a substantial difference it will be included on the final billing.

FLIGHTS if not specifically included in the tour package, or additional travel arrangements to the international departure point are the passenger's responsibility. (If purchasing domestic tickets more than 60 days in advance of departure date consider a flexible ticket allowing no charge or minimal charge for flight changes, as flight times can change up to the time of ticketing.) Arrive at the international departure point 3½ - 4 hours before departure time. TLC Holyland Tours is not responsible for changes to the flight schedule.

If personal reservations are necessary, TLC recommends use of the airline used by the tour for ease of assistance if requesting luggage be sent straight through. Service is also likely to be more prompt if difficulties in scheduling arise. The airline of choice may be used if no domestic flight is included in this package. Allow adequate time for connections in case of unforeseen delay. TLC Holyland Tours will not be available to assist, in any way, with personal reservations.

TRANSPORTATION is by modern air-conditioned-coach and by jet, economy class seating. **Upgrade requests needed 75 days before departure.**

PASSPORTS as required by Israeli law, must be valid for six months after the final day of stay in Israel. Passport cards are not acceptable travel documents.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS require you to be in good health – able to climb stairs and ascending grades without assistance; walk 3 -5 miles at a moderate pace on uneven terrain, and able to transport your own luggage. If you need assistance you must provide, at your cost someone to do this for you.
